Voice for Life South Canterbury has joined with other organisations who are concerned about the erosion of the Sanctity of Life. Of particular concern are the following two issues:

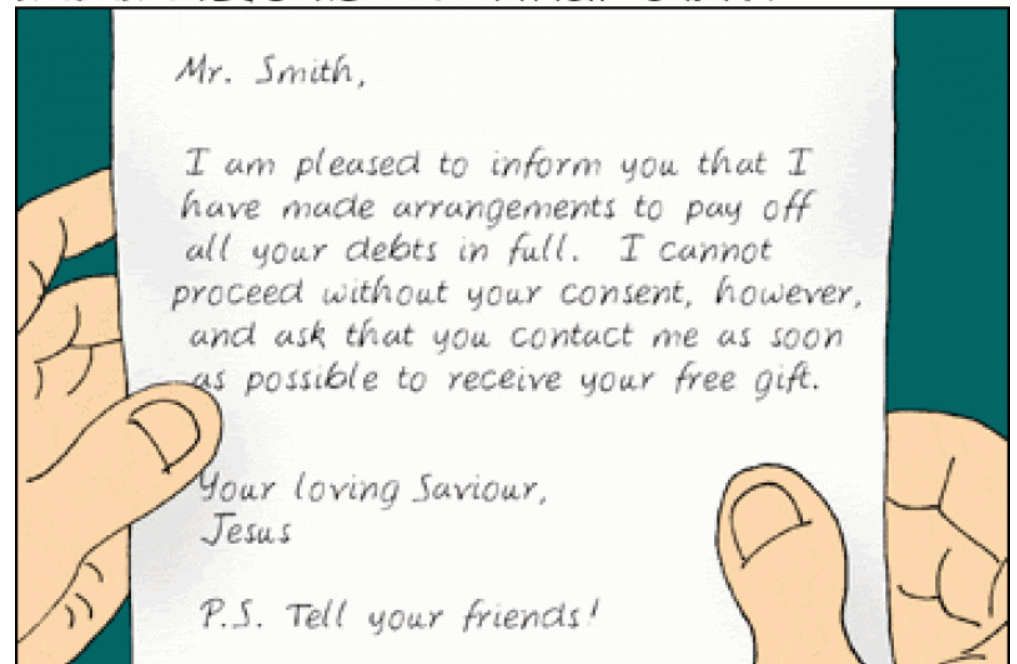
